

- The product number is the number you used to order your computer.
- The Model Number is a combination of the series number and product number. It tells you which model of computer you have in the HP 9000 Family. For example, the Model 216 refers to the Series 200 computer having the product number 9816.
- The Previous Model Number is the model number the computer had before the current, three-digit model numbering scheme was adopted. Recent models have no previous model number.

Any of these numbers can appear in the documentation. Just remember that they all refer to the same computer.
